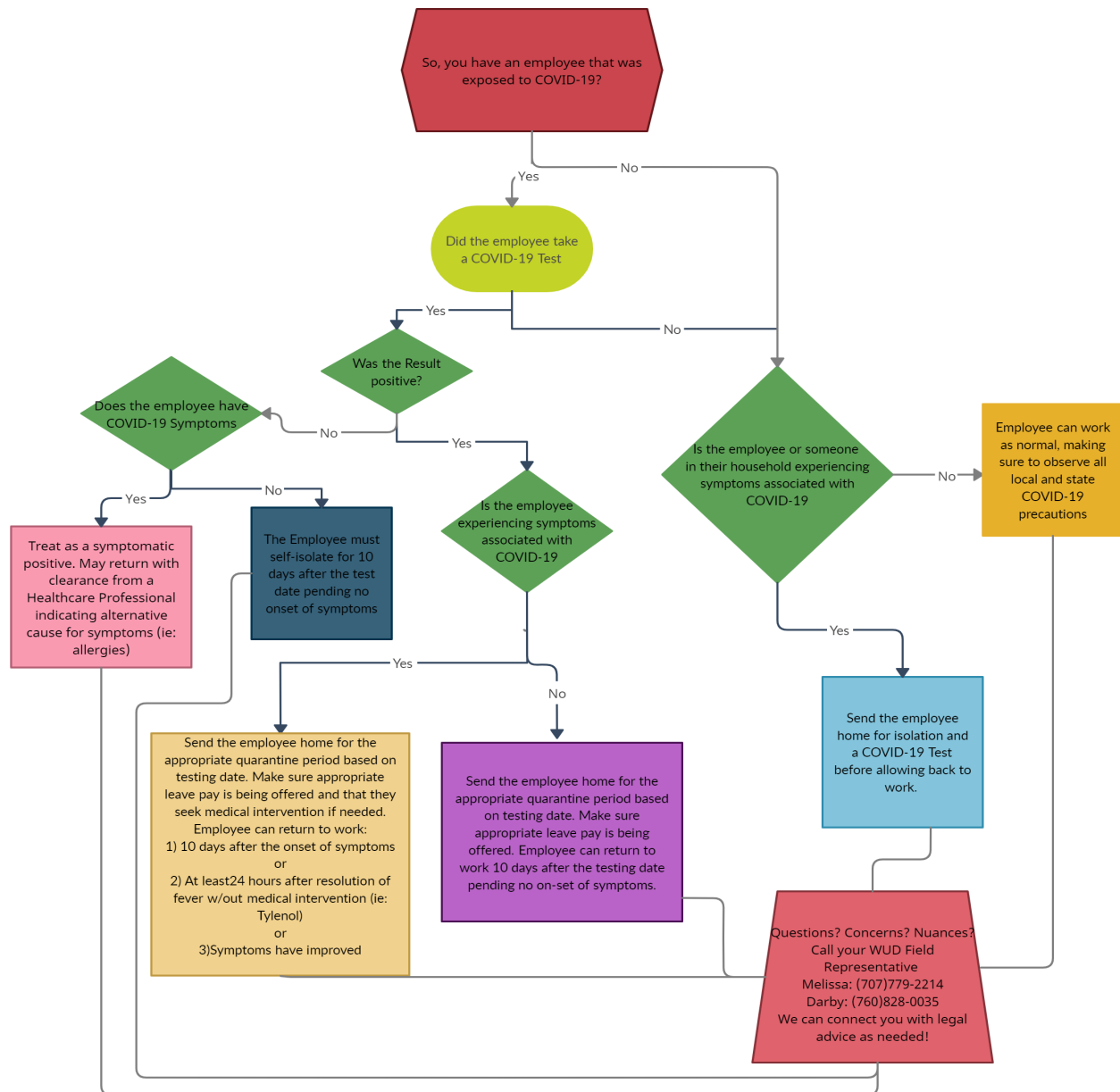


Potential COVID-19-Positive Employee Protocols for Dairies



Additional considerations to keep in mind:

- 1) All local and state COVID-19 Regulations should be observed on the dairy at all times, including: Use of masks and PPE when within 6ft of other staff, frequent disinfection of common tools/equipment, social distancing at least 6' apart whenever possible.
- 2) Employees that are required to self-quarantine should to stay home at all times for the appropriate time frame UNLESS they are being tested or seeking medical attention. Time Frames: 10 days from the date a positive test was taken or 24 hours from the cessation of symptoms without medical intervention (ie: no fever reducing medication)
- 3) Employees are entitled to 80 hours of paid leave per the 2020 FFCRA requirements. Make sure that employees who are out with a COVID-19 or Potential COVID-19 diagnosis are aware of their leave entitlements and are being compensated appropriately per these

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
